

LESOTHO VISA REQUIREMENTS:

If your country does not appear on the list below, you require only a valid passport to cross into Lesotho. If your country does appear on this list, you require a visa. 72 hour visas for Lesotho are now available at the Sani Top border post for R150. Longer term visas may be obtained either from a Lesotho Embassy or via one of the various visa agencies which operate in most countries around the world and who will get you a visa for a fee. See below for details on where to get visas in South Africa.
